



## Leaders in Action Individual State Project

**Project Deadline: Must be approved in badging system by adviser no later than March 24, 2023.**

*The Leaders in Action Project is a California FBLA state project designed to help FBLA members build on their capacities to positively impact the society in which they live. As members of Future Business Leaders of America, it becomes our responsibility to engage ourselves within the community to truly show leadership in action.*

**To complete this project, FIVE of the options from below must be completed along with the required evidence. When submitting project, please identify the options completed.**

### LEADERS IN ACTION

Option #1 Make a video on the importance of serving others in your community through FBLA and show it to your local chapter. Provide specific examples of how members can serve. Discuss ways FBLA can implement other means of service within the organization.

**Include a photo of your presentation and discussion with your local chapter. Provide a summary of the discussion.**

Option #2 Organize a supply drive (food, clothing, masks, hygiene products) and donate items to a local non-profit organization.

- What did you donate and why?
- How does donating support the community?
- How do you plan to continue to support others through COVID-19?

**Include pictures of you donating the items and a one-page write-up answering the questions above.**

Option #3 Research a nonprofit organization that contributes to a charitable cause.

- Why did you select the non-profit which you researched?
- How does the non-profit support the community?
- How do you plan to continue to support this non-profit organization?

**Submit a one-page write-up answering the questions above.**

## LEADERS IN ACTION

Option #4 Give a presentation about the FBLA organization to a local service group or business to gain support for your local chapter.

- How did you become acquainted with the service group?
- Get feedback and response from chosen service group about your presentation.
- What is your plan of action for service group to support your local chapter?

**Submit a photo of you presenting and a one-page write-up answering the questions above.**

Option #5 Host a zoom meeting with students from a local middle school or high school in your community that does not currently have an FBLA chapter and provide information on our organization and how to start a chapter.

- How did you select the school?
- Get feedback and response from chosen school group about your presentation.
- What is your plan of action to support this school group in establishing a local chapter?

**Include a screenshot of your zoom meeting and a one-page write-up answering the questions above.**

Option #6 Be an active member of a non-FBLA leadership group, or commission in your local community (i.e.: Associated Student Body, Key Club, JSA, City Youth commission, etc.).

- Describe the group you are a member of and why you choose to join
- Describe your role as a member of this group
- Describe how this group benefits the community and how it will impact your future college and career choice

**Include a picture of you attending a group meeting (virtual or in person), evidence of your membership (i.e.: membership card or adviser verification) and a one-page writeup answering the questions above.**

Option #7 Meet virtually or in person with school administrators, local school board members or elected city officials to discuss concerns in your community and how your local FBLA chapter can be a positive resource to address these concerns.

**Include picture of you with the people you met virtually with and an outline of your points of concern and how they might be addressed by your local FBLA chapter.**

Option #8 Participate in a fundraising walk, run, or event supporting a non-profit organization.

- What event did you participate in and why did you choose the event?
- How does this organization support the community?
- What other ways can you support this organization?

**Include a brief summary of the organization and a photo of you participating in the event.**
